#### **OLD BUSINESS:**

#### **FAIR OVERVIEW:**

Barn set up during fair went well and the nets built to fit over the poultry pens fit well. There was a tentative plan to make more net toppers for next year.

People loved the setup in the animal petting zoo during the fair. It wasn't set up until after the poultry show and there weren't enough panels, but the short panels that ended up being used worked well. Discussed: More green panels could be used for next year.

There was a discussion about fans and the high heat during fair week and if getting another swamp cooler is needed. Maybe a grant could be used to get another one. That will be looked into.

The Cat show during fair went really well. A new Judge is needed for next year.

There was good feedback on the judge used for the Dog show. Setup was amazing and fast. Show was one hour earlier, and it was really good to beat the heat. The same judge will be asked back for next year.

The Rabbit show went smooth and fast. Desiree judged. The clerks and new speaker worked well.

The number of entries in the Poultry were up and it went really well. Desiree judged and was fantastic.

It was discussed to create a Best of Show poultry and rabbit banner for next year's winners. Chris will reach out to Mid-State signs to ask how soon they need to know what to make. And then at the January workbook day or June meeting, kids can give their input.

It was also brought up to Showcase the winners for dog and cat, cavy and pocket pet shows in the small animal barn during fair week.

The Professional pictures were awesome, and everyone was very happy with them. They ended up costing \$450. The pictures are used for 4-H all through the year to promote 4-H.

Lastly, buying and using a barn leaf blower for the alleys in the small animal barn was brought up before fair. But during fair when one was used, it really blew up the dust. We will discuss and discern if using a board or tarp in the front of the pens to block the chip's from being scratched out would be helpful.
