- · Feed records
- · Break even price
- · Animal health care, medications, etc
- · Animal knowledge about breeds, anatomy, etc
- · Feed knowledge (what do you feed your animals)
- · Meat products
- · Marketing

**This list isn't exact questions that you may be asked but it gives you an idea of areas/topics that you should be ready to discuss.

Interview Questions you may be asked!

- · Why did you choose this project?
- · What did you enjoy most about your project this year?
- · What was the most difficult part of your project?
- What did you learn from the problems you encountered? What will you do differently in the future?
- · Who helped you with your project this year?
- · What new things did you learn this year?
- · How will you apply what you learned in the future?
- · Do you plan to continue your project again next year?

Tips for Interview Day!

- Arrive at your interview early
- Dress nicely for the interview... jeans and a nice shirt is perfect!
- · Greet your judge warmly with a handshake
- Be ready to discuss positive outcomes of your project, as well as areas that didn't turn out as well as you expected
- Prepare for your interview by considering what you learned, and what you would do
 differently
- · Relax and chat with your interviewer. They are happy to be there interviewing you!:)
