### JB Co. 4-H Policy Changes

The JB Co. 4-H Policies were updated by the 4-H Council and there are several changes that members should be aware of. The policy in it's entirety can be found on our website or a copy can be requested from our office. A few items to note:

- Enrollment Enrollment must be completed by
   November 30<sup>th</sup>. A late fee of \$25 per member/per month will be assessed starting December 1.
- Project Add/Drop date is now May 1st.
- Members intending to enter an exhibit at fair must attend at least 50% of all club meetings or events during the current 4-H year.

The Utica December club meeting and annual holiday events will be December 7<sup>th</sup>. This is a full day packed with fun and holiday cheer for your community!


