FOR THE TOWN OF EUREKA

As ratified by the voters on November 2, 1976, the government of the Town of Eureka shall be organized under the following provisions of Section 47A-3-203: Revised Codes of Montana, 1947.

In summary, this form allows for five elected persons who handle the town's business, meeting once a month in regular meetings. This form is the most widely used in the United States, and in Montana 123 towns and cities have functioned under this form.
