I would like to invite <u>ALL</u> Cloverbuds and 4-H Members in the Clothing and Textiles projects to enter the 4-H Showcase. We will have Sewing and Shopping in Style as well as a Quilt Show, Duct Tape, Costume, International Clothing, Display, and Refashion/Repurpose/Redesign Category. Registration deadline is April 4, by 5:00 pm in the Extension Office (NOT postmarked by).

Date: Saturday, April 19, 2024

<u>Place:</u> Expo Center at MetraPark

Time: Judging from 1:00-4:00 pm

Public Style Show at 4:30 pm

Members must attend all day and participate in the Public Style Show.

Registration Deadline: ALL registration forms must be received (not postmarked) by the Extension Office no later than Friday, April 4 by 5:00 pm, or points will be deducted.

<u>Registration Forms:</u> Enclosed with this letter are copies of all forms and the "Yellowstone County 4-H Clothing and Textiles Project Guidelines & Suggestions". This outlines in detail the classes and categories for Showcase. It is also posted on our website at: https://www.montana.edu/extension/yellowstone/4h/index.html.

<u>Buff</u> - This registration form is for the Sewing Project/Style Show. You sew your own garment or have done needlework items that can be worn. You can enter 2 outfits.

<u>Pink</u> - This is the Shopping in Style registration form. You can only enter one outfit. On the back of the registration form is a "comparison sheet". You <u>MUST</u> complete both sides of the registration. You will also be required to give a one-minute talk based on the information supplied on the comparison sheet. Be sure to write your notes on another card or know your talk well enough that you don't need notes.

<u>Salmon</u> - This registration form is for the Quilt Show. Quilts must be labeled as requested and brought to Showcase registration between 8:00-8:30 am on April 13. 4-H quilt makers (not adults) must be present at the Showcase to enter the quilt show for an interview.

<u>Purple</u> - This form is for display. The central focus is an item sewn by the member that can't be worn in the Style Show. It will be "on display." There will be an interview with a judge. The display will be like a window in a store. Maybe it's a fishing store or a costume shop--don't limit

Some ideas sewn by the members for the display include: doll clothes, costumes, backpack, beanie babies, pillows, hats and gloves, upholstery, napkins, curtains, fishing jacket, aprons, etc.

<u>Green</u> – This is the registration form for Costume, Costume – Shopping in Style, Duct Tape Fashion, International Clothes, Refashion/Repurpose/Redesign, Embroidery, Knitting, Crochet, and the Cloverbud Class. Members will be judged, and awards are given. Be sure to read the form to learn more about these fun areas and the requirements (including narratives and pictures) for each category.
